## INSTRUCTIONS

### GET STARTED

Put out your Spoilers sign!

Think you've got good bluffing skills? Like to make stuff up? Challenge the librarian to Spoilers! We'll pick out a book you want to read. If you can fool the librarian into thinking that the story ends differently than it actually does, you win! For ages 8-14.

### DAY ONE "Knock-knock Script"
